Re: Status of Asbestos in our Building
Date: September 9, 2020

In 1990 all friable containing asbestos materials was removed from our school. This was done in complete compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA Law). However, as in all buildings, there are still materials (especially in the boiler room) which contain a minimum amount of encapsulated asbestos. This asbestos is not considered a health hazard, but it still is required by law that you know that such materials (although safely contained) are still present in our building. The statement below is taken from the Asbestos Management Manual:

This notification is required by the Asbestos Hazard Response Act (Ahera 40 CFR Part 763 of Title II Toxic Substance Control Act). An Asbestos management plan continues to be followed at East Boston Central Catholic School. This plan is available and accessible to the public in the schools administrative office."

Again, this notice is procedural only. All friable and /or dangerous asbestos was removed from our school years ago. You are welcome to review our comprehensive report at any time.
